

## Specific Certification Standards Grass - Forage

### I. General Seed Certification Standards as Applied to Forage Grass

The General Seed Certification Standards as adopted are basic and together with the following specific standards constitute the standards for certification of forage grass.

### II. Field Inspections

#### A. Handling the Crop prior to Inspection:

A field must be rogued and/or sprayed sufficiently during the growing season to remove any mixture of grasses and noxious weeds.

#### B. Time of Inspection:

An inspection must be made during the growing season at a time when there is sufficient growth to make the identification of grasses and noxious weeds.

### III. Field Standards

#### A. General

##### Isolation requirements

A field to be eligible for the production of registered or certified planting stock must be isolated from any other strain of the same species by a strip at least 10 feet wide to preclude any possibility of mixing.

#### B. Specific requirements
