## General Program:

**Matt Renfrow**, Assistant Director, NC Crop Improvement Association. He will review the seed situation for soybean and wheat for the southeastern states.

**Jim Burnette**, Director, Structural Pest Control and Pesticides Division, NCDA&CS. Pesticide regulatory issues will be discussed: the 2008 Governor's Task Force and its recommendations; the requirements of Senate Bill 847; the Pesticide Board's rulemaking on additional pesticide record keeping requirements for pesticides covered under the Worker Protection Standards; pending rules by the Board on interim protection measures for the Carolina Heelsplitter mussel; the Board's consideration of rules dealing with pesticide containment structures; EPA's recent actions regarding soil fumigants; the impending October 2009, landfill ban on most pesticide containers.

**Berry Lewis**, Bayer CropScience. Berry will update us on the latest in plant protection materials from Bayer CropScience.

**Robert Wright**, A.R. McKay Processing Machinery, Inc. Robert will describe the latest in equipment for seed conditioning plants.

**Bill Scruggs**, Osage Inc. Bill will inform us of the plans to use barley in their plant. This will have tremendous impact on seed supply for NC.

**Dr. Arnie Oltmans**, Agricultural and Resource Economics. He will relate the latest in the farm credit situation.

**Dr. John Havlin**, Soil Science Department, NCSU. John will discuss factors influencing demand for food, fiber, and fuel and will include declining farm land, pricing of fertilizer and grain, and population.

**Paul Lilly**, Associate Professor Emeritus Soil Science Department, NCSU. Paul will review the change in demographics from ancient history to modern days and the impact it has had on agriculture as we know it.
